The Stober family is continuing the inventive and social tradition of the historic estate, always committed to the common good. The father of German mobility, August Borsig, was Europe's most famous railroad and locomotive manufacturer. The entrepreneur's friendship with Humboldt and Lenné was based on their shared love for nature and gave the impetus to found Europe's first in-house corporate social system. The Borsig architects were the best of their time. The last Borsig who resided at the Landgut was a member of the Kreisau Circle – the largest resistance group against the Nazis.

exhibition „Landgut Stober and the Kreisau Circle“. Weinstube with 80 indoor and 120 terrace seats, on the ground floor the old Lithographie Werkstatt, the Borsig steam engine „Dicke Bertha“, as well as the Salons Paul and Hedwig, 1st floor the Panorama, on the 2nd floor Salon Tet-Arnold, above Raum der Stille

Park

AUGUST BORSIG was an early member of a horticultural society, today known as the „Deutsche Gartenbau Gesellschaft 1822 e.V.“, his son ALBERT redesigned the entire field and forest area as well as the village and Landgut in a sustainable way

his great-grandson MANFRED V. BORSIG prohibits to connect the Landgut with the name Borsig

administration and office

Lake Groß Behnitz

with diverse fish population, adjacent to the Westhavelland Nature Park, a paradise for ornithologists

Riding stable & coach house

formerly also served as accommodation for the cavalry captain

Portal

the figures by CARL VON GONTARD came from the former Oranienburger Tor in Berlin

Gutsverwalter

with the Salons Albert, Anna and Mathilde, as well as the Salon der Entscheidung as a wedding room and two waiting rooms, Salon Braut and Salon Bräutigam

Rinderstall

now houses Salon August on the ground floor and the Salons Ernst, Arnold and Conrad on the 1st floor for conferences or celebrations

Behnitzer Dorfstraße

the 4-row avenue was created and planted by ALBERT BORSIG

Courtyard

Trade fairs, exhibitions and celebrations up to 3000 people take place on 6000 m² of Mark Brandenburg cobblestones

Bio-Hotel, Reception

completed in spring 2020, hotel with 146 rooms, Information for visitors, farm store

built by EUGEN SCHMOHL, Hotel with 26 rooms

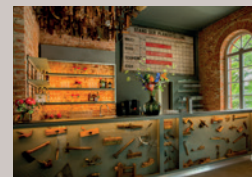

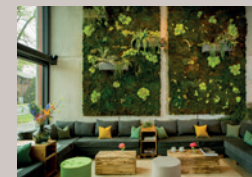

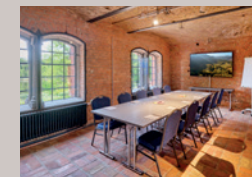

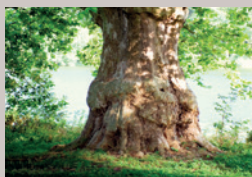
