


Welcome to the pulse of time!

The Liederhalle lies at the very heart of the busy city centre and is therefore the perfect event venue – easy to reach with a wealth of different recreational possibilities.

The Kultur- und Kongresszentrum Liederhalle lies at the very centre of Stuttgart, a 'Top Ten' convention location. Reach us in a matter of minutes on foot from the central train station and city centre or conveniently take public transport right to our door. The Bosch Areal is located close by, a 'Convention City in the City', with its bars, restaurants, shops, cinema and gym. Moreover, thanks to a direct link, your guests can also return to the neighbouring MARITIM Hotel Stuttgart under cover after the event.

The central location of the Liederhalle makes it simple to organise your accompanying events programme. Cultural highlights include the award-winning State Opera, the State Ballet and a host of museums and galleries. The Königstraße shopping mile is only a short distance away. A wealth of other possible excursion options in the immediate surrounding area promote networking and a relaxing conclusion to your event.



A unique events venue

Large and small works of art, multi-angled halls, sharp angles, sweeping galleries – organic architecture, fine arts and brilliant acoustics merge here to form a single entity. The Kultur- und Kongresszentrum Liederhalle has a very individual character, which is sure to linger long in the memories of your guests.

Regardless of whether you wish to organise a church convention, medical conference, award ceremony, literature reading, traditional concert or rock gig – the Liederhalle is as fascinating and multifaceted as your guests. Built in 1956 by Rolf Gutbrod and Adolf Abel, and extended in 1991 by Wolfgang Henning, the world-famous concert venue has been transformed into an internationally renowned convention centre following the addition of the convention wing. The Liederhalle is a traditional modern building with great charisma, which is closely linked to the history of Stuttgart. Many well-known artists and sculptors have been immortalised by and in our rooms, thereby creating a unique events venue that attracts high-calibre stars and events time and time again. Your event or your convention will also be elevated to something very special in this ambience!

Our halls and rooms are well-known for their outstanding acoustics. All rooms also feature state-of-the-art equipment, which is constantly kept up to date.


The technical features of the rooms at a glance:

Our rooms at a glance

The Kultur- und Kongresszentrum Liederhalle has over 5 large halls and 14 conference and meeting rooms. Our halls cannot fail to impress visitors with their individual architecture and offer space for a large number of guests. The foyers can also be flexibly used as exhibition space, as a dance floor or as a reception area. They can also be used as meeting and communication spaces with their open stairwells. Multi-day conferences with parallel workshops and exhibitions can thereby be simply linked. Partition walls ensure that our conference rooms can be flexibly used.
